Alberta Education, through its annual Assurance Measure survey, holds Alberta schools accountable and seeks to provide assurance to the communities we serve. As part of our strategic Education Plans and Annual Education Results Reports, Third Schools also provides local measures to further support accountability and assurance.

Cognia— a US based global accrediting agency with 40K institutions in 90+ countries with more than 11M students under its auspices— is focused on a continuous improvement model. Third School is distinguished as the sole Canadian school system to have gained Cognia ESA (system) accreditation.

Teachers and students will be completing their surveys over the next few days so that we collect feedback to satisfy accountability and assurance objectives.

STUDENT REGISTRATION FOR THE 2024-2025 ACADEMY YEAR

There is significant desire amongst Alberta families for choice in education. Third Schools has been satisfying this desire since 1997.

The 2024-2025 registration cycle is upon us. Third Schools offers all seats to current families first. Below, you will find the deadlines to submit your application. After the deadline dates, we will start offering any empty seats to new applicants. Once all seats are filled, we will create a waiting list.

Please note that demand for Third Academy, LYNX, and ursa seats for the 2024-2025 academy year is extremely high.

Also, please note that we have been upgrading our application processes so that we can go paperless and you can complete and submit your student's application over SchoolCloud. I ask everyone to please forgive technical glitches as we upgrade the application process system wide.

When the upgrades are completed, parents will receive an email directly from SchoolCloud with log In information. There will be a link to log in and create a password protected account (if you do not have an active account already). Log in. From there it's a step by step process, hopefully pretty straight forward.

INBUS: TRANSPORTING OUR STUDENTS SAFFLY AND ON TIME

Almost 150 Third Academy and LYNX ECS students are daily riders on a system that provides service to many communities in Greater Calgary and beyond including Airdrie, Cochrane, Langdon, Chestermere, and Okotoks.

InBus Transportation Manager Tammy Morton-Renyk and her team of professional school bus drivers have been doing a super job getting students from point A to B and beyond every school day this year. I am pleased to see significant improvements in system reliability since our restart in January 2024.

Our Telus fleet tracking system shows that, with very few exceptions, our school buses are running on time. And when there are delays—usually resulting from traffic, weather or unanticipated mechanical issues—our transportation staff always tries to do their best to accommodate.

InBus doesn't just provide daily home to/from school service. We have a Calgary Transit connector bus that links up with both their MAX and Access services. The entire Third Schools community benefits from InBus as our yellow buses are also used for field trips, 'nature inspired' programming, and other educational adventures.

Third Schools made a substantial investment in our bus system by adding three new school buses for this academic year. This is part of our ongoing commitment to modernize our fleet and grow InBus.

So please, if you see or talk to Tammy or a member of her team, be sure to take time to thank them for their commitment to our students. They are out their in the cold, rain, and wind as early as 5:30am in the morning and as late as 6:00pm in the evening to make sure that our kids have a safe and enjoyable ride every school day.

THIRD SCHOOLS WEST CAMPUS

Some of our families might not be aware that Third Schools has two Calgary campuses. In addition to our East Campus at 400 Prince of Way, we operate our West Campus in the Glenbrook community at 3311 49 St SW.

Opening the West Campus was a critical component of our COVID strategy that served the Third Schools community well. We now utilize the West Campus for our LYNX ECS and LYNX Calgary onsite programs.

Third Schools has made a substantial investment in the West Campus including the installation of a nature inspired playground as well significant improvements to the classroom and common areas including new flooring throughout.

Our stay at the current West Campus site was only intended as a temporary arrangement. While the location has served us well, there are many factors that make it unsuitable for long term occupancy as a school site. We are actively exploring new sites to reestablish LYNX programming in the West.

As with our move into the East Campus, our goal is to find a property that will best serve the needs of our LYNX West communities—LYNX ECS, LYNX Calgary, and LYNX Cochrane—into the future.

Further information about a new site for our West Campus will be shared with our families as it becomes available.
