### A SEASON OF HOPE, FREEDOM, AND CONNECTION

Dear Third Schools Families:

The poet Walt Whitman—after traveling through our country—once observed that Canadians are "quite as American as the best of us." Our children are engaged and learning. Across our school system, they are finding their own daily success. Third Schools was designed to meet the diversity of the families that we serve. Fundamentally, we are providing hope, freedom, and connection to ensure that our children thrive. We are humbled to fulfill this noble cause.

While our programming was not interrupted by the recent public school teacher strike, we recognize the existential threat. We are concerned by the recent misguided campaign arguing that independent schools should not receive provincial funding. The fact is that independent schools save the taxpayers of

Alberta hundreds of millions of dollars each year. This defund independent schools campaign presents as a threat to parental choice and, most importantly, student success.

We are an independent community of teachers and learners. We believe in the power of education and fully support teachers, students, and their families. Our position is clear: we support students, parents, and teachers in advocating for a fully accessible publicly funded world class, affordable, and safe provincial education system. This includes all the education choices—public, Catholic, franco-phone, charter, independent, heritage language, ECS, and home school—currently available to all Alberta taxpayer families.

Over the last three decades, we have evolved from a single focus on special education into a comprehensive independent school system: Third Schools. Today, we offer diverse programming choices—including parent-directed home education,

shared responsibility, online learning, hybrid instruction, ECS programming, and nature-inspired education—through our three schools: Third Academy, LYNX and **ursa**.

We have grown into a community of 101 professionals serving over one thousand students across Alberta and beyond. And we continue to look forward.

### Expanding Our Horizons

I am incredibly excited about our future initiatives. There is so much happening across our school system.

Parents of Students with Additional Needs (SWANS) find themselves, at times, in a place of hopelessness. They are often desperately looking to find a school that will help their children. We know that this community is underserved. With the addition of modular classrooms at our East Campus, Third Academy will create 40 more seats for September 2026, followed by another 40 seats by September 2027.

We believe that every child on this planet deserves access to an affordable, world-class, and safe education. We know that education 'lifts a person from a cycle of poverty'. An Alberta High School Diploma is highly valued and opens doors to top universities and colleges worldwide. **ursa** Global online—our global brand—delivers hybrid programming 'anywhere, anytime'.

We are also in the conceptualization stage of the LYNX Priddis World School. We have identified a pristine

country property near Priddis, southwest of Calgary. This would be a dream site for a university preparatory, 'nature inspired', world school serving local LYNX day students and Alberta/Canada/Worldwide LYNX boarding students. We are currently seeking a champion, an international partner, and a developer to meet our planned occupancy for January 2028.

While the most vital communication always takes place directly between parents and their specific school, I want to share a high-level highlight of the incredible momentum we are seeing across our system in 2025-2026.

### Third Academy: Giving Hope

Third Academy is operating at full capacity this year with a few seats available at the high school level.

To meet the needs of our students, Rehana Mattu, Principal, has onboarded additional staff who are proving a strong complement to our returning team. Demand for our programming remains exceptionally high—we already have a significant number of prospective families on our waiting list for the 2026-2027 school year!

We are also continuously improving our support services:

### Psychology Department

Counselling Therapy continues to be delivered as part of student programming. We have also made changes to support faster turnaround times for psych-ed assessments.

### SLP/OT Services

We have restructured our Speech & Language Pathology (SLP) and Occupational Therapy (OT) services to ensure we are meeting the specific needs of our SWANS (Students with Additional Needs). The new teams are delivering services from ECS to Grade 9.

### InBus Transportation System

Our student bussing ridership is at an all-time high with over 150 daily riders! Our students are lucky to have their dedicated and caring professional drivers bringing them to school daily. Investment in new buses has also made the ride a little more comfortable.

## Expansion

## Enrollment

Student numbers in both our LYNX Calgary and LYNX Okotoks programs have doubled since last year.

## Instructional Teams

We have recruited new teaching staff for LYNX Calgary, LYNX Cochrane, and LYNX Edmonton adding strength to our instructional teams.

## Kindergarten

We have room to grow in our LYNX ECS program in Calgary. Spread the word and give a Kindergarten kid the best start to their schooling life ever!

ursa continues to be a first choice for home based hybrid education in Alberta because it is defined by one word: freedom.

Tracy Gilluley, Principal **ursa**, knows that our homeschooling families have chosen **ursa** because of this freedom. This is the same with our online and onsite families who are looking for programming flexibility. It is the freedom for families to design an education that fits their lives, rather than fitting their lives around a system. Whether through flexible scheduling, global travel, or pursuing passion projects, we provide the platform for your child to learn without limits.

We are also expanding the freedom to learn for our families by expanding:

### New Course Offerings

We are adding new optional asynchronous courses, providing more interest led learning pathways for our students, and opening programming choice to non-primary students.

### ursa Summer School

For the first time, **ursa** will offer a range of summer school courses in July 2026. This will enable students to 'accelerate' and/or 'upgrade' their learning over the summer.

### ursa Summer Study Camps

We are thrilled to announce the launch of our Summer Study Camps in July 2026. Open to international and local students for 2 or 4-week stays, these unique camps blend adventure, culture, and language into an unforgettable experience.

Right across **ursa**, we have reached our enrollment targets with only a few seats available in the online classrooms. Given demand, we will create more junior high classroom capacity for September 2026 .
